The Campaign had its latest meeting on September 10, 2014. The outcome of that meeting was the following message, which went out to all supporters of the Campaign:

The Campaign for US Ratification of the Children's Rights Convention (CRC Campaign, www.childrightscampaign.org) held its 2014 Annual Meeting in Washington, DC, on Wednesday, September 10, 2014.

1. The Campaign recently sent to President Obama a letter that you may view at <http://www.childrightscampaign.org/take-action>, signed by more than 110 leaders of U.S.-based organizations, urging him to send the CRC to the Senate this year, the 25th Anniversary of the Child Rights Convention. We urge all of our supporters to communicate similarly to the President.
2. We need your help to celebrate Universal Children's Day, November 20, 2014, which is the 25th anniversary of the UN General Assembly's approval of the CRC. These celebrations are not just about children generally, but about the rights they share everywhere in the world, as recognized in the Convention on the Rights of the Child.
